

The [Johns Hopkins Disability Health Research Center](#) is recruiting a postdoctoral fellow:

This posting is for a Postdoctoral Research Fellow with a doctoral degree in epidemiology, biostatistics, public health, or other related field for interdisciplinary field to conduct research focused on advancing health equity for people with disabilities. This includes work related to the impact of COVID-19 on the disability community. The position will be with the Johns Hopkins University Disability Health Research Center for an initial period of 1-year with an opportunity for renewal. Competitive annual salary (NIH-level minimum will be ensured) and benefits such as health insurance and tuition are provided.

Expectations of this work include:

- Identifying health inequities for people with disabilities using national survey data, cohort studies, healthcare claims, and other sources of data
- Determining factors that impact health outcomes for people with disabilities, including gaps in accessibility
- Leading and independently conducting statistical analyses
- Writing and presenting resulting research

Successful candidates will have strong communication and writing skills, be prepared to work collaboratively in a diverse team of researchers and should have a demonstrated ability to code in one or more programming languages (e.g., STATA, R, etc.).

This position will be integrated in a highly collaborative research team, and will include working with faculty, staff, and students within the Disability Health Research Center, as well as across the University. The Johns Hopkins University and the Disability Health Research Center have a strong institutional commitment to diversity, equity, and inclusion and strongly encourages candidates from all underrepresented groups. Additionally, candidates who promote interdisciplinary perspectives, intercultural understanding, and concern with social responsibility and the ethical implications of knowledge and action are preferred.
